BLM - Qualifying class for 2008 BLMs. Riders must be members of a participating organization at the time of the show to be eligible
GAIG - Qualifying class for the 2008 GAIG/USDF Championships (*declare qualifying ride on entry form*) – Entry fee plus additional \$10 fee required,
MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS. Rider and owner must be USDF participating members and USEF members; horse must be USDF Lifetime registered and USEF recorded. Owners may be USDF Business Members. Except for FEI Junior or Young Rider Freestyle entries, competitors in freestyle qualifying classes must submit a photocopy of a test verifying eligibility to enter class.

Open - Open to all Horses and Riders—Show management will split AA's and JR/YR based on class size

AA - Open to Adult Amateurs only; competitors must compete as adults from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 22 & they must hold a current USEF Amateur card.

JR/ YR – Open to Juniors and Young riders only; Individuals are eligible as JR until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 18 or YR until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 21 (*specify on entry form*).

TOC - Test of Choice (*specify test level on entry form*). May be qualifier if correct test ridden.

MFS – USDF or FEI Musical Freestyle only; no Pas de Deux or Quadrille.

** Class #223 is a USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal Program Class.

++ Any USEF test not offered in class list above. Excludes DSE, MFS and Young Horse Tests. Please specify test level on entry form.

May ride any FEI test that does not have a specific class. Excludes MFS, Young Horse, Para-Equestrian tests. If ponies are entered and in need of measurement card, an appointment for measuring MUST be made with show management prior to the show. Please specify test level on entry form.

General:

- Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- Management reserves the right to split, combine, delete, or add classes dependent on entries. Management also reserves the right to add or substitute judges or make any changes required by circumstances.
- Each barn has one sharps container per 50 horses available (USEF GR 1211.5). Competition Management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- If a competitor NO SHOWS their first class of the day, they may be considered a SCRATCH for the remainder of the day at show management's discretion.

Awards:

- Trophy(in classes of 3 or more) and up to six ribbons in each class.
- High score awards for NC Bred High Score Award. Must submit copy of breed papers listing NC breeder.
- Class #223 is a USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal Class

Levels:

- Current editions of USDF Intro, USEF TRAINING LEVEL through FEI GRAND PRIX.

Entries:

- 2008 Region 1 Entry Forms Required.
- Entries accepted ONLY with entry form and payment. Entry form must be signed in ALL THREE signature blocks in accordance with USEF rules, as well as signature in COACH block if applicable. Only original signatures accepted.
- Proof of membership (USEF/USDF) must be included with entry form. Please provide the Master Verification from USEF & USDF (www.eqverification.org) although membership cards (or photocopies) are still acceptable. Membership affidavit fee is \$5.
- The show committee reserves the right to refuse entries (USEF Rule V), make changes, deletions or corrections as deemed necessary.
- Negative Coggins valid through the last day of the show is required for entry to show grounds for all horses. Entries without a current Coggins WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. A photocopy is acceptable provided the date, results, horse name and vet signatures are legible.
- DO NOT send entries registered, certified mail or Signature required. No telephone, FAX, or e-mail entries.
- Post entries (**received after the closing date, June 30**) will be accepted on a space available basis, for a \$20 post entry fee

| \$25.00 Day Parking (per day/for all horses not stabled) | \$10.00 class change fee (during show) |

- Make checks payable to: **GREY HORSE ENTERPRISES.**
- Until closing date, refunds on entries minus \$20 office fee. **NO REFUNDS after closing date, including stabling and overpayments, for any reason including Acts of God, Inclement weather, other emergencies and/or terrorism.**
- Fees must be paid in full with entry form. If a check for entry fees is returned, the entry will be placed on a waiting list until all fees are paid in cash, money order or cashier's check. **ALL RETURNED CHECKS ARE SUBJECT TO A \$30 SERVICE FEE.**
- Junior Exhibitors exempt from the \$5.00 USEF Breed/Discipline fee (USEF Article 204).
- Show office will be open: 4pm—7pm Friday, 7am—7pm Saturday, 7am—1 hour after show ends on Sunday.

Guest Horses:

- Must register with the Show Secretary, provide completed entry form, show proof of current Coggins, pay \$35 fee plus Office Fee (includes office fee). Grounds/stabling fees are additional.

Acknowledgements/Times:

- Acknowledgement of entry showing status will be emailed (or mailed) to each competitor. Please check for errors and notify the secretary immediately.
- Times will be available on the website (www.greyhorse1.com) approximately one week prior to the competition date or by phone from the secretary the Monday prior to the show. **TIMES WILL NOT BE MAILED.**

Stabling:

- Permanent 10x10 stalls, with sliding doors, in central-aisle barns.
- **Please order extra bedding in advance. Pay at check-in, do not prepay.**
- Facility stall will remove center partition for horse double stall (\$150 rate for weekend) if ordered by closing date. Limited number of stalls available. Please indicate on entry form.
- Riders **MUST** provide emergency contact information on their entry form.

Arenas: All are 20 x 60 meters

- Competition: Two indoor with composite footing. Three outdoor with sand/stone dust combination.
- Warm-up: One covered with composite footing. One indoor with composite footing, three outdoor with sand/stone dust combination.

Hospitality: Food available on grounds during lunch hours.

Accommodations: Host hotel: Fairfield Inn (252-799-0100). Special horse show rates.

Directions:

SBM Eastern Ag Center, 2900 NC Hwy 125 So., Williamston, NC 27892. Located just off NC 64 (just 48 miles east of I-95). From NC 64, take exit 512. Turn south, SBM Ag Center is 100 yards on right. TRAILERS, drive past mail entrance, take next right on Allen Williams Road (less than ¼ mil) for easier, direct stabling access.
