Freestyle TOC - State level on entry (must submit photocopy of 60%+ ride in highest test of level, or higher. *Test of choice - any IPEC, USEF, USDF, or FEI test not offered in show class list above, as eligible. May be qualifying classes only if correct test is ridden.

Eventer's TOC: any current USEF, USEA or FEI Test not listed individually. Specify test on Entry)

LEVELS

Intro - Grand Prix. All tests will be current editions.

AWARDS

Trophy and six ribbons. USDF/Dover AA Medal.

ENTRIES

EACH ENTRY MUST HAVE COPIES OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION ATTACHED.

Include LEGIBLE e-mail address on entry. Full refund if scratch is received by closing date less \$15 office fee. No refunds after closing date or after start of competition. This includes classes cancelled due to severe weather or other emergency conditions. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Late/Post entries will be accepted as possible or put on a waiting list to fill scratches. All “No Shows” that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

Guest horses are welcome but must send in a completed entry form with the \$15 office fees, submit a current coggins, and pay either stabling or day parking.

Music for freestyles must be on cassette tapes or CDs provided by the competitor to announcer at least two hours prior to the start of the freestyle class.

DIRECTIONS

From I 95 South - Exit 20, NC 211 W in Lumberton and travel approximately 20 miles to Raeford. Follow NC 211 thru Raeford. Travel approximately 7 miles and turn right onto Montrose Road. Follow straight 2.3 miles to the park. Turn right onto Calloway Road to Gate 8 for stabling and ship in entrance. Spectators, volunteers and staff go straight ahead and follow signs for appropriate parking.

Directions from 95 North -Take Exit 31, NC 20 at St. Paul, Travel approximately 12 miles towards Raeford and turn left onto NC 211 thru Raeford. Travel approximately 7 miles and turn right onto Montrose Road. Follow straight 2.3 miles to the park. Turn right onto Calloway Road to Gate 8 for stabling and ship in entrance. Spectators, volunteers and staff go straight ahead and follow signs for appropriate parking.
