Q = GAIG/USDF Qualifying class for 2011 – State Q on entry and add \$10 or will be considered open.; J = Juniors and Young Riders only - list birth date on entry; O = Open; A = Adult Amateur-enclose copy of USEF Amateur card with entry. Freestyle TOC - State level on entry. *Test of choice – any USEF, USDF, or FEI test not offered in class list above.

Classes may be split in the following divisions depending upon the individual class entries: OPEN, AA, JR/YR. Note: Divisions AA & JR/YR may be combined.

LEVELS: Intro – Grand Prix. All tests will be current editions.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES – Training and First. Exempt from Horse ID/Membership reqs.

FREESTYLE AWARDS: Awards for top 3 FS Scores for the entire show (USDF & FEI combined)

AWARDS: Trophy (in classes of 3 or more) and 5 ribbons. See website for High Score Prizes.

USDF/Dover AA Medal. Jessica Palmer Memorial Award (High Score AA over 50 years of age).

AQHA APPROVED: Scores of 60% + at Training Level 4 and higher can earn AQHA points.

Include legible e-mail address on entry. Full refund if scratch is received by closing date less \$20 office fee. No refunds after closing date or after start of competition. This includes classes cancelled due to severe weather or other emergency conditions. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Post entries will be placed on a waiting list to fill scratches. All “No Shows” that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the show and time slots may be filled.

Guest horses are welcome but must send in a completed entry form with a \$35 user fee plus the \$20 office fee, submit a current coggins, and pay either stabling or day parking.

Music for freestyles must be on cassette tapes or CDs provided by the competitor to announcer at least two hours prior to the start of the freestyle class.

ARENAS

Two 20 x 60 sand competition arenas: one indoor w/spectator seating, one outdoor. Covered warm-up arena. No one on foot is allowed in the warm-up area—coaching must be done from the side.
